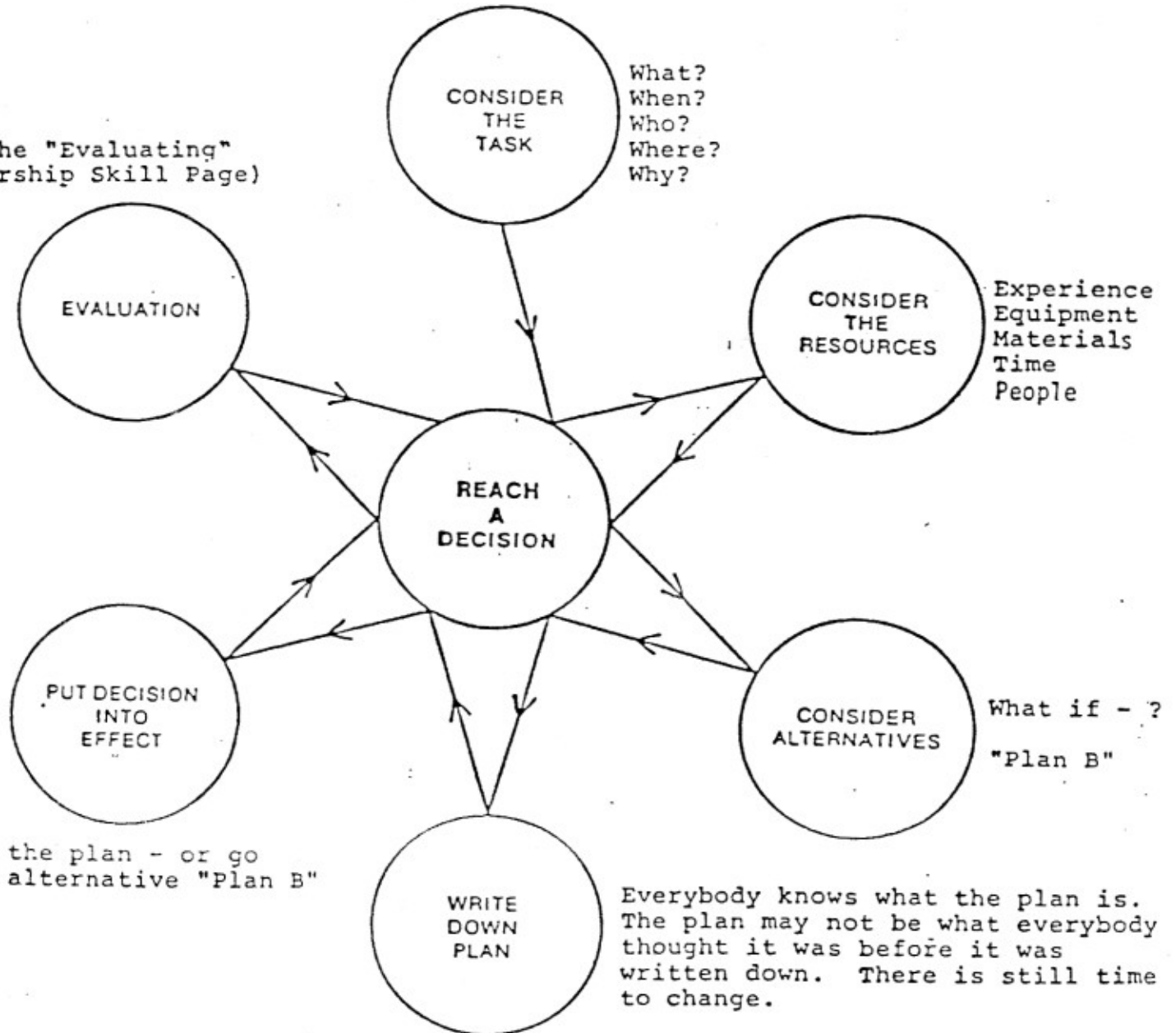


PLANNING

Listed below is an outline of a routine which will help you to plan effectively. Start with Consider the Task, Reach a Decision, go to Consider the Resources, go back and Reach a Decision, and so on all the way around the circle. If you do this, you will plan well.
